

Terms and Conditions

Introduction

These terms and conditions include our privacy policy and are collectively referred to as the “Terms”.

When you use this website you agree to be bound by these Terms.

Certain uses of this website are restricted or prohibited. Please see clause 2 below for further details.

These Terms are a legally binding agreement between us. We may at our discretion amend or change these Terms from time to time. The current version of these Terms will apply whenever you use this website.

We charge subscribers for the right to use Bottlebooks to share and download information about wine. These charges are shown on the website and may be changed from time to time.

Restrictions on Use

You agree not to:

2.2 use automated software to view our services and to only access such services manually.

2.4 transmit material protected by copyright without the permission of the registered owner

2.5 use our services in any way that is illegal or harmful to others.

2.6 include links to this website in any other website without our prior written consent.

Content

- 3.1 All content uploaded to our website will be considered non-confidential and non-proprietary and we shall have the right to grant access to others in accordance with our subscription levels.
- 3.2 All views expressed by users on this website do not represent our views.
- 3.3 All content that you upload must be accurate (when you state facts), genuinely held (when you state opinions) and comply with applicable law in the country where they were posted.
- 3.4 Your content must not contain material which is defamatory or obscene or offensive.
- 3.5 We shall determine at our discretion whether you have breached this clause 3 and we may take any action that we deem appropriate to rectify the situation. This may include temporary or permanent withdrawal of your right to use the website and the removal of any material posted by you.

8.1 You can visit our website without having to provide personal information. You will remain anonymous and any information provided to us by your internet browser such as page view connection, length of stay will also be anonymous.

8.2 Registration is required to use our web-based applications. If you register, we collect name, e-mail address and password. This data is not shared without your express consent.

8.4 You can link your Facebook account with Bottlebooks. Through this link you can sync profile data about your business and events with Bottlebooks. We do not track any personal data from Facebook.

8.5 Bottlebooks enables data exchange between partners. If you use this service, Bottlebooks stores your information about your business, events and products which is only accessible to others if you specifically authorise it.

8.6 We use your data for processing complaints. We also analyse data for statistical purposes but always on an anonymous basis.

8.7 You have the right at any time to obtain details of the personal data stored about you. You can correct, amend or delete it. If we are using data that required your consent, you can withdraw that consent at any time.

8.8 Like many websites we use “cookies” to enable us to personalise your visits to the site. Cookies are small pieces of information stored on the hard drive of your computer by your internet browser. You can set your browser options to prevent the use of cookies but by doing so you may reduce the functionality of our website. We use Google Analytics to evaluate use of our website. Google produce reports on website activity, in the course of this a truncated version of your IP address may be transferred to the Google server. It will not however be linked to any other data held by Google.

8.9 Bottlebooks uses social plugins from Facebook, Google+ and Twitter. If you choose to use them, these social plugins may request personal and non-personal information from you. We recommend that you exercise caution and check your rights before responding to such requests.
